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ELIGIBILITY

To apply for this Scholarship these are the requirements:

- At least one of the parents or the student applicant must be a registered member of Saint Martha's Parish. To be considered a registered member the parishioner should attend mass regularly and use the offertory envelope.
- The student applicant must have a letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university (undergraduate), for the 2026-2027 academic year.
- The enrollment must be as a part time or full-time matriculated student no later than fall of 2026.

Failure of any requirements will result in a rejection of the application or the forfeiture of the award. The applicant could re-apply for the award in the future, after fulfilling all the requirements.

Awards are open to any field of study.

The applicant's participation in Church, extracurricular activities, volunteer activities and work experience will be also considered.

We encourage applications from young adults of all parishioners.

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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

This application must be completed and signed by both the student and one of the parents.

The following materials are required to complete this application:

- A one page typed with a signed personal statement of the student, describing the student's goals and future aspirations. The goals can be academic, civic, social and/or personal. It could include a discussion of any circumstances of which the applicant wishes to inform the committee.
- A list of the applicants extracurricular and volunteer activity and/or work experience.
- All Applicants will have an in-person interview with the Selection Board on the 3rd Sunday of May at the Parish Office. The Board will inform all applicants of the time.
- An essay, describing volunteer experience, extracurricular activity, or a personal experience in no more than 2 pages, how the experience benefited others. Describe what happened in your life or in the life of your family, because of such event. Families include parents, grandparents, siblings, guardians, relatives, friends, or people in your community.
- High School Transcript including SAT scores are required.
- A photographic State issued ID must be included.
- The student must provide verification of acceptance from the school of choice. If this is not available by April 13th, 2026, please submit the application and the documents before the deadline and send a copy of the acceptance as soon as it is received. The Scholarship funds will not be released until they are submitted.

For the application to be considered all requirements must be met, except for transcripts and verification of acceptance if they are not available. Transcripts can be mailed directly from the school.

Scholarship Award will be made without regard of gender, race, age, national origin, or physical challenge.

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SELECTION CRITERIA

As mentioned before, the selection is entirely made by a committee comprised of several members of Saint Martha's Men of Saint Joseph and some prominent parishioners of Saint Martha's Church who will review or rate the eligible applications and make the final decisions on the scholarship award based upon the criteria set forth below. And they will conduct an in-person interview on the **3rd Sunday of May** at the Parish Office. The Board will inform all applicants of the time, which usually will be between the masses.

The following criteria will be considered equally in evaluating applicants:

- Church Participation
- Career Goals
- Personal Statement
- Extra-Curricular Activities
- Volunteer Activities
- Work Experience
- Financial Need
- School Recommendations
- Collage/University Acceptance Letter
- Volunteer Essay

In the case of a tie between 2 applicants Church participation will be the determining point.

The Scholarship award must be utilized by September 18th, 2026, failure to do so will automatically disqualify the recipient and the Scholarship award will fall into the runner up. No exceptions will be accepted.
